Camping: From Friday 27th April to Sunday 29th April



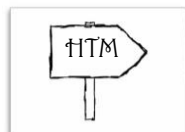

Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn and it is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order.
